A blend of 65% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, and 15% Syrah, it has 25% of the blend raised in a new oak foudre, with the balance in older oak."

Juicy red fruit beneath, with really succulent structure, an finely sanded tannins that could support medium-term cellaring. Seems as if there should be good potential for complexity in future."
